LOCAL CONTEXT

With the support of several financial partners, HAMAP- Humanitaire, in collaboration with the FAPMMN Foundation, has set up a drinking water supply system in the isolated rural commune of Sola in the Democratic Republic of Congo.

To date, the network includes:

- Protection and catchment of a water source
- A reservoir with settling tank
- A 55m3 water tower
- 3 km of network (PEHD63)
- 6 standpipes and 5 administrative connections

In addition to the construction of these facilities, the population was made aware of good hygiene and water management practices, and several management committees were set up to monitor the service. Buoyed by the success of this project, the FAPMMN Foundation has once again approached HAMAP-Humanitaire to extend the network already in place and enable as many people as possible to benefit from easier access to water.
