LOCAL CONTEXT

Cambodia is one of the poorest countries in the world. In 2014, its HDI ranking was 143rd. Despite its many natural resources, Cambodia today retains a high rate of poverty, and above all, despite positive economic signs, a sharp increase in income and wealth inequality. This is especially true in rural areas, where three quarters of the population lives. Water and sanitation remain key issues for development in Cambodia. Although the Global Development Goals concerning access to water were largely achieved in 2015 with 69% of the rural population having access to safe drinking water sources (76% at the national level), those concerning sanitation coverage are still very low.

This project is part of an institutional cooperation between the Loire Bretagne and Rhine Meuse Water Agencies and TSA (Tonle Sap Authority). A first identification mission had been conducted in May 2015 with a member of HAMAP-Humanitarian, TSA and L'Oleau in order to determine local needs and find a local partner. Following this first mission the commune of Putrea was designated as a priority area by TSA and Rainwater Cambodia was chosen to be the local partner to follow the project locally.

MAIN ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

// Training of school teachers and the WASH support committee in good hygiene practices and awareness raising for school children.

// Awareness-raising, organized by the trained teachers, of schoolchildren on individual, family and environmental hygiene, and celebration of handwashing day.

// Installation of a water filtration station.

- // Set up the ATPC sessions in the 3 villages.
- // Install latrines for 181 families living below the poverty line.

// Develop personal initiatives in the installation of latrines with the establishment of local entrepreneur on the sale of hygiene products, WASH infrastructure.
