LOCAL CONTEXT

In order to improve the sanitary situation of the inhabitants of the Preah Vihear provinces, a two-phase project for the construction of a sustainable drinking water supply system has been set up in the Putrea commune. This action accompanies the implementation of an integrated management of the water resources of the Stung Sen basin and meets the priority needs of its inhabitants. The global approach, the involvement of the population and the local authorities ensure the efficiency and the sustainability of this action. This second phase consists in the extension of the water network following the construction of the water tower.

MAIN ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED

- // Training of school teachers and the WASH support committee in good hygiene practices and awareness raising for school children.
- // Awareness-raising, organized by the trained teachers, of individual, family and environmental hygiene among schoolchildren and celebration of handwashing day.
- // Increase in the water supply network put in place during the first phase.
- // Setting up a water distribution system for neighboring villages.
- // Implementing the ATPC sessions in the 3 villages.
- // Develop personal initiatives in the installation of latrines with the establishment of local entrepreneur on the sale of hygiene products, WASH infrastructure.
