LOCAL CONTEXT AND PROJECT

Jalboun is a village in the north-east of the West Bank, right next to the separation wall and Israel. It is one of the last villages in Palestine without a drinking water supply system for its inhabitants, who rely on tanker trucks.

A hydraulic master plan was completed in 2018 to remedy this situation. Most of the network and works are currently under construction by the Palestinian Authority and the World Bank. French cooperation wishes to complement this action by offering support to the Jalboun Municipal Council, aimed at creating, equipping, training and structuring a municipal water department capable of managing the network over the long term and delivering a quality service to the population.
